Acceptable scores made in Virginia throughout the year must be posted to a player's scoring record. Virginia does not observe an inactive posting season. Scores made in a state observing an inactive season are not acceptable for handicap purposes.

Equitable Stroke Control (ESC) sets a maximum number of strokes that a player can post on any hole and is incumbent upon that player's Course Handicap. For handicap purposes, a player is required to adjust hole scores when they are higher than the player's maximum ESC number.

10 through 19	7
20 through 29	8

9-Hole Course Handicap	Maximum Number On Any Hole
4 or less	Double Bogey
5 through 9	7

20 or more	10
