USGA EXEMPTION EVENT

For the first time, the winner of the VSGA Amateur Championship will earn

automatic qualification into the U.S. Amateur Championship. Additionally, all four semifinalists will be exempt from local qualifying into the 2025 U.S. Amateur. This year's U.S. Amateur will be held Aug. 12-18 at Hazeltine National Golf Club in Minnesota (with Chaska Town Course serving as a stroke-play qualifying co-host). Last year's U.S. Amateur champion, Nick Dunlap, won on the PGA Tour as an amateur in January and turned professional shortly thereafter.

 He reached the semifinals of last year's event at Boonsboro before falling to Wood, the eventual champion.
- In addition to the college players listed, one entire college coaching staff has qualified for the Amateur. William and Mary head coach Tim Pemberton and Tribe assistant coach Mike Leach both advanced to the championship proper. Pemberton grabbed the final spot at the VSGA's Last-Chance Qualifier at Mattaponi Springs Golf Club.
- Only one mid-amateur (age 25 or older) has won the championship in the last 12 years: Trey Smith, who had turned 25 just before winning his title in 2018 at The Federal Club.
- This is only the third time since 2011 that the Amateur has been contested at a Northern Virginia club. River Bend in Great Falls hosted in 2020, and The Club at Creighton Farms in Aldie hosted in 2017.
- The stroke-play qualifying medalist has won the Amateur twice since 2004. Joey Lane was medalist and champion in 2016, and Mark Lawrence Jr. was co-medalist (with Brandon Berry) and champion in 2020.
- Steve Serrao earned his spot in the field by winning the VSGA Senior Stroke Play Championship earlier in June. He's one of four seniors (50 or older) in the field. Thomas Garner, Scott Shingler, and Alan Myers are the others.
- Host club Belle Haven will be represented by three players: Brandon Cigna, Owen Love, and a player to be determined in a qualifier scheduled for Friday, June 21.
- Two VSGA clubs will have five players each in the field: Dominion Valley CC (Bryce Corbett, Tate Corbett, Scott Shingler, Jordan Pastor, and Nathaniel Winebarger) and Roanoke CC (Jason Spaar, Justin Young, Nate Faulkner, Samir Davidov, Uzar Mirza).
