

FIELD NOTES

The "working man's championship" makes its way to Poplar Grove. Open to players ages 25 or older on the first day of the competition, the VSGA

Mid-Amateur is one year shy of celebrating its 50th birthday. This edition features two past champions - Marshall Tinsley (2019) and Justin Young (2017). Tinsley (pictured) grew up in the area and played prep golf at nearby Amherst County High School before heading to George Mason for his college career. Young has had a solid 2025. He advanced to the championship match at the VSGA Amateur in June and is fourth in the VSGA Player Rankings.



- Two Mid-Amateur rookies to watch are 2022 State Open of Virginia champion Nick Taliaferro and 2024 VSGA Amateur semifinalist Drew Brockwell. Taliaferro, a former Radford standout, turned 25 last December. Brockwell, a mainstay on Virginia rosters for the Virginia-West Virginia Team Matches and Captain's Putter Matches, played at Virginia Tech.
- Gus Lascola (Hidden Creek CC) is the youngest player in the field, having turned 25 late last month. At 59, Laurel Hill GC's John Richards is the elder statesman of the field.
- Defending champion Jordan Utley is not in the field.
- · Ryan Stinnett, who teamed with Jason Pool to win the VSGA Four-Ball Championship in May, has a little local knowledge of Poplar Grove. He owns a house adjacent to the golf course and has been a longtime member of the club. Stinnett was a standout at Virginia Tech who played in two VSGA Amateur finals.
- Stinnett is one of three Poplar Grove members in the field, joined by Tyler Lapp and Willy Davidge.
- Several players who have competed in past U.S. Mid-Amateur Championships are in the field, including Andrew Crowley, Joey Jordan, Kyle Bailey, Brandon Ramsuer, and Justin Young.
- Bailey teamed with Will Collins to win the VSGA Multi-Format Team Championship in April.
- The club with the most members in the field: Birdwood Golf at Boar's Head Resort with five - Brian Belden, George Riser, Gray Ellington, John Welsh, and Milt Small.
- VSGA Manager, Course Rating & Member Services Brian Wright is taking a step away from his work duties to compete in this event.
