FIELD NOTES

Bob Bailey ended Keith Decker's four-year reign as Mid-Senior Amateur champion and heads to Winchester Country Club in search of a repeat. The Mid-Senior Amateur features players ages 60-64 and serves as a gateway for players transitioning to the super senior ranks. Decker aged out and is now playing in the 65+ Super Senior Amateur. Another to watch in the Mid-Senior Amateur is Kent Erdahl, who is eligible to play in the Super Senior Amateur but is choosing to stay in the Mid-Senior Division. Erdahl lost out in a playoff at the 65+ VSGA Super Senior Stroke Play Championship.



- The 65+ division is by far the largest at this event. Dave Pulk is back to defend the title he won last year at Danville Golf Club. He's joined by a strong field that includes past champions Jack Allara and Tim Vigotsky, four-time Mid-Senior winner Keith Decker, past Super Senior Stroke Play 65+ winner Mike Howell, and past VSGA Senior Amateur champion Tim Kelley.
- The VSGA Super Senior Golfer of the Year race is still wide open, and the results at Winchester will go a long way to deciding the winner. Allen Barber put his best foot forward by winning the 65+ Super Senior Stroke Play at Cedar Point in July, and he'll look to add another title to his resume at Winchester.
- Since the championship split into age divisions starting in 2009, three players have won back-to-back championships: Harry Cain in 2011-12, John Cuomo in 2019-20, and Robert Gardiner in 2023-24. Gardiner is back in the field this week, seeking to become the age division's first three-peat winner.
- Gardiner will face some stiff competition, including Jim Woodson, his opponent in last year's final, along with past 65+ winners Jeff Flax and Dayton Slater.
- Flax won the 70+ division at the VSGA Super Senior Stroke Play Championship at Cedar Point in July, nipping Slater in a playoff.
- Defending champion George Owens headlines the 75+ field, along with past champion John Casstevens, Owens' longtime four-ball partner. Others to watch include past 65+ winner Bill Engel and Mike Brown, who has won a pair of Super Senior Stroke Play age division titles in the past. Tom Grady, who won the 75+ VSGA Super Senior Stroke Play, is not competing.
