FIELD NOTES

Keswick Club broke through in last year's morning shotgun, ending a string of wins in this event by Richmond-area clubs that had stretched back to 2016. Keswick is running it back with the same team this year, with Craig Fenton and Kyle Bailey (pictured) on one side and Will Collins and Boston Craddock on the other. Keswick was only the second Charlottesville-area club to win this event, joining Farmington CC, which won the last of its four titles in 1955. There are plenty of other clubs to watch at The Foundry as well.



- Magnolia Green GC features the brother combo of Liam and Noah Maclauchlan, which has won the last two MAPGA/VSGA Junior Four-Ball titles and took second at last year's VSGA Four-Ball.
- Lakeside Park Club in Richmond welcomes former Virginia Tech standout Drew Brockwell as a member, and he'll team with John Rosenstock. Brandon Ramsuer and Blanton Farmer are Lakeside's second side.
- Hermitage CC will look to get back in the winner's circle with a strong team featuring VSGA Team Championship winners Ben and Sam Beach, past VSGA Mid-Amateur winner Jordan Utley, and professional Charlie Hanson.
- Hidden Creek CC features a pair of players who placed in the top five at last year's VSGA Mid-Amateur in Colin Kent and Gus Lascola.
- Chatmoss CC's entry features a pair of past State Open of Virginia champions in Keith Decker and Jerry Wood, along with Brandon Grogan and Ricke David.
- There are two women in the field, as past VSGA Women's Mid-Amateur winners Lauren Greenlief (International CC) and Shabril Derco (Cedar Point Club) will tee it up.
- The Foundry's A team will again feature a quartet of strong players, including new member Scott Bemberis, who has played for a winning Independence GC side in the past. Four-time State Open winner Jay Woodson, VSGA Senior Amateur finalist Paras Pandya, and Ren Schiffman round out the home club's roster.
- Independence, winners in 2019 and 2024, does not have an entry in the field.
- The Federal Club, winners in 2022 and 2018, will look to Ryan Taylor, Jeff Spears, Spence Andrews, and Tom Vlahakis to return to the top.
