FIELD NOTES

Back-to-back champions have been hard to come by in the VSGA Four-Ball championship in recent years. But if there's one player who knows how to successfully defend a Four-Ball title, it's Ryan Stinnett, who partnered with Keith Decker to win consecutive titles in 2006 and 2007. Stinnett and Jason Pool will look to defend their title won last year at Williamsburg GC. Pool has joined the senior ranks since winning last year at age 49 and competed in this year's Senior Four-Ball, playing with Francesco Romano to tie for fifth.



- Blake Carter and Adam Houck won this event in 2022. Both are in the field but with different partners, Carter with fellow Chatmoss member Brandon Grogan and Houck with Steve Serrao.
- In all, five members of the home club are competing, with Dustin Hussey and Wesley Smith pairing together, and Chatmoss member Austin White teaming with Bryce Varner.
- Two sides that participated in the 2025 U.S. Amateur Four-Ball Championship are in the field: Ryan Rettberg and Nick Brediger, and Brandon Ramsuer and Kyle Bailey.
- A pair of past champion sides are in the field: 2020 winners Nick Taliaferro and Andrew Kennedy, and 2021 winners Andrew Crowley and Clark Taylor.
- There are three sides comprised of brothers competing: Channing and Benson Blevins; Charles Green IV and Garland Green; and Rory and Dan Ailor.
- Nick Alexander and Patrick O'Rourke had themselves a day in qualifying, posting a 12-under 60 at Bide-A-Wee GC that included 10 birdies and an eagle.
