Two rounds of stroke-play qualifying, with the field cut to the low 60 players and ties after Day 1. Top 16 advance to match play. Round of 16 and quarterfinals on Wednesday, with the semifinals and 18-hole championship match scheduled for Thursday.

FIELD NOTES

It's fairly rare that the previous year's finalists return to play in the following year's edition of the VSGA Junior Match Play Championship, but that's exactly the case this year and defending champion Charles Lange and returning finalist Ethan Evans will both tee it up at Stonehenge. Lange is playing in one of his last major junior events before beginning his college career at Columbia University, while Evans (pictured) is coming off a VSGA Junior Stroke Play Championship title and an appearance at the U.S. Junior Amateur Championship.



- Several players who finished in the top 10 at the Junior Stroke Play earlier this month at Pete Dye River Course of Virginia Tech are teeing it up at Stonehenge: Evans (champion), Samuel Francis (T4), Jamie Bliley (T4), Lange (T7), Isaiah Cantrell (T7), Jake Lopes (T9), and Colton Rodgers (T9).
- Rodgers is the 2025 VSGA Junior Stroke Play Champion and was one of three stroke-play co-medalists at June's VSGA Amateur Championship.
- Cantrell, a recent Floyd County graduate headed to play college golf at Radford, was in the mix at the Junior Stroke Play until a tough back nine in the final round.
- All four semifinalists from last year's Junior Match Play are participating: Lange, Evans, Lopes, and Luca Rinaldi, the 2025 State Open of Virginia low amateur and a semifinalist at this year's VSGA Amateur.
- Does that name sound familiar? Maybe it should. Among those in the field are Mason Young, the son of 2025 VSGA Amateur finalist and past VSGA Mid-Amateur champion Justin Young; Larry Loving, the son of past VSGA Four-Ball champion Larry Loving Jr.; and Max Bradshaw, the son of another past VSGA Four-Ball champion, Robert Bradshaw.
- There is one VHSL individual state champion from 2025 in the field: Finn Watson, who won the Class 6 title with Washington-Liberty High School.
- The championship match at the Junior Match Play has not reached the 18th hole since Adam Ball won in 19 holes in 2011.
- Among the past champions of this event are current PGA Tour player Michael Brennan and two-time State Open of Virginia champion Mark Lawrence Jr.
