FIELD NOTES

The original working man's championship celebrates its golden anniversary at Bay Creek Club and Resort. Wayne Jackson won the inaugural edition in 1977, four years before the USGA created a national championship for players 25 and older. The VSGA Mid-Amateur was originally for players 35 and older, but the age was lowered to 30 in 1982 and eventually 25 in 2008. The VSGA's Hayden Hundley took a deeper look into the event's history [in this story](#) from the September-October *Virginia Golfer* issue.



- **Drew Brockwell:** No. 1 in VSGA player rankings. Was low amateur at the State Open of Virginia, reached the round of 16 at the VSGA Amateur, was sixth in stroke-play qualifying at the Amateur and took third at the RGA Mid-Amateur.
- **Joey Jordan:** Broke through for first VSGA individual title at last year's Mid-Am. Has played a limited schedule this year but partnered with Brockwell at the U.S. Amateur Four-Ball.
- **Kyle Bailey:** Tied for fifth in the VSGA player rankings, thanks mostly to a T10 finish at the State Open, a T2 finish at the VSGA Four-Ball and a second-place finish at The Signature at The Federal Club. Has been part of four winning sides in VSGA partner championships, but is seeking his first individual title.
- **Brandon Ramsuer:** No. 8 in VSGA player rankings. Top finishes include advancing to the round of 16 at the VSGA Amateur and a T2 finish at the VSGA Four-Ball (with Bailey).
- **Sam Beach:** Has won two partner VSGA titles with brother Ben but is seeking his first VSGA individual crown. Sam reached the round of 16 at the VSGA Amateur and finished T5 in the mid-am division at the Valentine Invitational.
- **Justin Young:** Won the 2017 VSGA Mid-Amateur and was finalist at the 2025 VSGA Amateur. Reached match play at this year's Amateur, falling to eventual finalist **Scott Shingler**.
- **Adam Houck:** Has some history at Bay Creek, as he teamed with **Blake Carter** to win the VSGA Four-Ball at the club in 2022. Finished T2 at the VSGA Four-Ball this year at Chatmoss.
- Others to watch include past champion and three-time VSGA Amateur finalist **Jordan Utley**, past VSGA Amateur champion **Trey Smith** and past State Open of Virginia winner **Nick Taliaferro**.
- The winner earns an automatic spot on the Virginias Captain's Putter roster.
- The VSGA has introduced a Mid-Amateur Golfer of the Year for men and women and will award it for the first time in 2026.
