# FIELD NOTES

Jon Hurst rode the home-course vibes at Fredericksburg Country Club to victory in last year's Senior Stroke Play, and he'll look to become the first player to win back-to-back Senior Stroke Play titles since Keith Decker in 2013-14. There will not be another home-course victor this year--no Wintergreen members are in the field. Hurst remains a dangerous threat to win his third title, having also won in 2021 at Two Rivers CC. Hurst has finished in the top three at each of the three VSGA Player Rankings events he's played in this year.



- Dave Williams Jr. broke through for his first VSGA title back in May, partnering with Roger Newsom to win the VSGA Senior Four-Ball title. Williams leads the VSGA Senior Player rankings thanks to that Four-Ball win and an individual victory at the Peninsula Amateur. He was second at the Fredericksburg Amateur and tied for third at The Signature at The Federal Club.
- Tom Vlahakis was part of the three-man runner-up contingent last year at Fredericksburg and has played stellar golf to start this season, claiming titles at The Signature at The Federal Club and the Fredericksburg Amateur.
- Tazewell's Buck Brittain has been a force in Virginia senior golf since turning 50, and his victory in 2023 in this event at Winchester Country Club completed a "Senior Slam," with wins in the Senior Stroke Play, Senior Open, Senior Four-Ball, and Senior Amateur championships.
- Past VSGA Amateur champion Scott Shingler is still seeking his breakthrough in this event. He'll look to improve upon last year's runner-up finish.
- Steve Serrao continues to contend just about every time he tees it up. He won Senior Stroke Play titles in 2022 and 2024 and was runner-up last year. Serrao still splits time between regular and senior events, and his T13 spot in the Senior Player Rankings reflects the fact that he's only played in two senior events this season.
- Other past event champions in the field are David Jordan (2019), Dave Pulk (2017), Mike Krulich (2016), and Tim Kelley (2011-12).
- Jim Kite, a 2023 Virginia Golf Hall of Fame inductee, won the Senior Stroke Play the last time it was played at Stoney Creek in 2000, winning by two strokes over Tom Vogt and Jamie Gough.
