FIELD NOTES

Only players in the 65+ age division receive player rankings points for this event. One newcomer to the division is already making a major impact – **Bob Bailey** (pictured), who won two VSGA Mid-Senior Amateur titles before joining the super senior ranks when he turned 65 in March. Bailey and partner **Michael Hays** lost in a playoff in the 65+ division at the Super Senior Four-Ball Championship in June. Though Bailey hasn't won a player rankings event this year, he's finished second (twice), T5 and T6 in the events he's entered.



- **Keith Myers**, who enters this championship atop the player rankings list, has one individual win (Fredericksburg Amateur) and two partner wins (Allegheny Amateur, Matt Chandler Memorial Four-Ball) this season.
- The VSGA went to age divisions for this championship starting in 2020. Of the winners since then, three are in the 65+ field (**Allen Barber**, **Mike Howell**, and **Jack Allara**). The only ones not in the 65+ are 2022 winner **Kevin MacMillan**, who won the last time Lake Chesdin hosted this event, and 2021 and 2024 winner **David Partridge**, who is playing in the 70+ division.
- Allara is having another strong season, having finished inside the top five of every player rankings event he's entered in 2026, including runner-up finishes at the Fox Puss Invitational and Danville Golf Clue Invitational.
- The 65+ division has generally been close since its inception in 2020. Only two championships since then have been decided by more than one stroke, and two have been decided in playoffs.
- **Kent Erdahl**, one half of the winning 65+ side at the Super Senior Four-Ball is playing. His partner, **Dave Pulk**, is not in the field.
- Eighteen players are in the 70+ division, led by defending champion **Jeff Flax**. Others to watch include Partridge, Jeff Hudgins (who was part of last year's 70+ playoff), and Jim Woodson, who was part of the winning 70+ side at the Super Senior Four-Ball.
- **Terry Towler**, who has won titles in the 70+ and 75+ divisions, will look to add another title to his resume at Lake Chesdin. Joining him in the 75+ is **Mike Ancel**, whom Towler partnered with to win this year's Super Senior Four-Ball 75+; **Mike Brown**, who won the 75+ division in 2023; and **George Owens**, who has won 75+ Super Senior Amateur titles but none in the 75+ division at this event.
