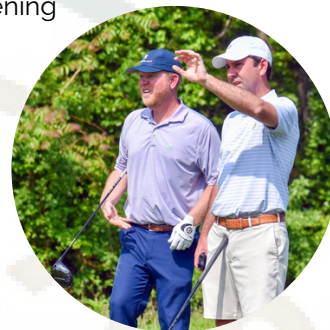

FIELD NOTES

The VSGA Team Championship – gone is the bulky name, but what remains is the VSGA's traditional season-opening competition that includes one round of two-person captain's choice and one round of modified alternate shot. Formerly known as the Multi-Format Team Championship, the event returns to the Dominion Club for the sixth time in eight years. The other two were contested at Spring Creek. The Senior and Super Senior Team Championships will be contested later this summer at The Golf Club at Mattaponi Springs in Ruther Glen.



- Last year's event was cut to one round due to rain, meaning the two-person captain's choice portion wasn't played. Three sides tied for the 18-hole lead at even-par 72, with Kyle Bailey and Will Collins coming out on top thanks to a birdie on the second playoff hole.
- Bailey will look for his third title in this event with a third different partner. Bailey won the inaugural edition at Spring Creek in 2019 with Jeff Long. With Collins not participating this year, Bailey has teamed with Zack Wehrman, a member at Hermitage CC.
- Ben and Sam Beach (pictured above), the only side to win both the VSGA Four-Ball Championship and the Team Championship, will look to replicate their success from 2023, when they finished two strokes clear of Justin Young and Scott Shingler. There's one other brother combo in the field: Ben and Braden McGrath.
- Brandon Ramsuer and Ryan Taylor are the only two-time winners of this event, having won in 2020 and 2024. They're back in the field this year.
- John Rosenstock, who won this event with Trey Wren in 2022, will look to add to his trophy case with partner Brock Kelley this year.
- One side to watch features a pair of players who competed in the 2024 U.S. Mid-Amateur at Kinloch Golf Club – Andrew Crowley and George Ordway. The latter also advanced to match play at last year's U.S. Mid-Am in Arizona.
- Adam Horton and Del Baker, who were part of last year's three-side playoff in this event, are in the field.
- Marshall Tinsley, who is partnering with Adam Marshall for this event, has history at The Dominion Club, winning the VSGA Mid-Amateur at the club in 2019.
- Adam Houck and Blake Carter, who won the VSGA Four-Ball title in 2022 at Bay Creek, are in the field.
