FIELD NOTES

For the first time in recent memory, the host club of the VSGA Women's Amateur Championship features several members who are contenders to hoist the Kohler Trophy on Thursday.

Vanderbilt sophomore and RCC member

Kathryn Ha (pictured) enters the championship as the top ranked Virginian in the World Amateur Golf Ranking at 260.

Other Roanoke members to watch are **Alisa Davidova** and **Ashnoor Kaur**, both of whom have participated in the U.S. Women's Amateur Four-Ball Championship.



- You can't talk favorites without talking about **Lauren Greenlief**, a three-time Women's Amateur champion and seven-time VSGA Women's Golfer of the Year. Greenlief partnered with **Jackie Rogowicz** to win this year's VSGA Women's Four-Ball (Open) title and has racked up top-10 finishes in the Women's North Atlantic Amateur, Women's Open of Virginia, European Mid-Amateur Ladies' Championship, and AGA Women's Amateur Championship.
- Greenlief is the lone past champion competing. Last year's winner, **Sky Sload**, turned professional at the end of last season. She's also the only past finalist, ensuring that there will be at least one first-time finalist come Thursday afternoon.
- The Women's Amateur last visited Roanoke in 2020, with **Tatum Walsh** topping **Julie Shin** 5 and 3 in the final match. That marked the first year that stroke-play qualifying was reduced to 18 holes.
- Several schools are well represented in the field. Virginia Tech's **Alina Ho** and **Emerson Dever** are playing, as is future Hokie **Kennedy MacCleery**, the winner of June's Women's Open of Virginia. UVA is represented by active players **Elsie MacCleery** and **Kiera Bartholomew**. William & Mary's **Faith Garcia** and **Jennifer Osborne** are in the field. Kaur and Davidova are both committed to play at Missouri.

USGA EXEMPTION EVENT

The winner of the VSGA Women's Amateur Championship will earn automatic qualification into the U.S. Women's Amateur, to be held August 4-9 at The Honors Course in Ooltewah, Tenn. Last year, Sky Sload earned the exemption and missed qualifying for a playoff for the final match play spots by one stroke.
